## **A Word according to the Guidance of the Holy Spirit**

Do you have confidence in God?

There is still talk about Resurrection Day, nearly two weeks later, and some remember the details of what Jesus went through and they ‘appreciate’ what He DID—isn’t it what was DONE to Him?! I heard some talking about ‘SUCH love, that Jesus died for ME!’ and others mentioning some details of His death ‘ Without Jesus’ death I would not have been HERE today!’ one told me while we were evangelizing on the street a week after Resurrection Day. What matters ‘He is not here: for **HE IS RISEN**, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay!’ Matt 28:6.

Since Jesus is RISEN from the dead, He proved to those who love Him and those who hate Him that He IS the Christ. Right now He is reigning from the Heavenly Zion, thus we have hope and we are waiting for His Second Coming. Those who were contemporary to Jesus and SAW with their own eyes the LIVING Christ, must have had a DIFFERENT hope and different faith. But today we should have the SAME faith like them after the Resurrection of Jesus and should have

more confidence because of ALL what the Lord did since then. We should remember our Lord went through the same things we are going through, and He was faithful until His death on the cross, but stayed obedient, never sinning. What an example to follow, but we are NOT following Him or imitating Christ as we are told in the Bible!

I want you to ponder with me about this Verse: “For we have not an High Priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin” Hebr 4:15—are you familiar with this verse as most Christians are?

I want you to SEE here that the Lord Jesus, our High Priest, feels our sufferings along with us; He was in the flesh like you and I and could feel thirst, hunger and even tiredness. In other words, the Lord is personally touched by all pain, confusion and despair that we feel; these things are NOT strange to Him. The Bible makes it clear that there is nothing we experience that He has not endured also, in one way or another. Well, since we have such a great High Priest, we are instructed “Let us therefore come boldly unto the Throne of Grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need” Hebr 4:16.

In other words we are being told ‘Your Saviour knows exactly what you are going through and He knows how to minister His grace to you’—did you get the message?! Brother, we have heard most of the theological definitions of grace: unmerited favor; the goodness of God; His special love...etc. BUT when trials come, we have a choice of how we will react. I am sure you’ve had your ‘share’ of temptation and life is so terrible sometimes (Often?!). Not matter how much grace you receive, the temptations we are facing frustrate us and we feel like ‘abandoned and lost’!

I pray and hope that you are familiar with the Book of Job; God said about him ‘And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that **there is none like him in the earth**, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil?’ Job 1:8

In the book of Job, we see that Job’s wife became embittered at the unspeakable tragedy they were suffering and all the losses and attacks they had to endure. Job’s wife foolishly blamed God and urged Job to “Curse God and die!” Job 2:9.

She was saying, in essence, “Why would the Lord bring down such unthinkable tragedy on this godly family?”— Very understandable according to the HUMAN Standard. But to prove that God is just and won’t allow such a thing without a purpose, Job, in his great grief and anguish, declared, “Though He slay me, yet will I trust Him” Job 13:15. You could say Job was saying ‘It doesn’t matter if these boils take me to my grave, I’ll never give up my confidence that God knows what He is doing or why He is allowing such THINGS to happen to me. Even though I don’t understand anything about any of this, I know God has some eternal purpose’

I don’t know how much confidence do you have in God and whether you appreciate God’s wisdom; what I know, which means IT IS A FACT, our God is The All-Wise God, and though we do NOT understand what He is doing, I ABSOLUTELY trust HIM. Are you, dear brother, trusting Him and KNOWING that “... all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to His purpose” Rom 8:28—this KNOW means with ALL confidence we trust Him and trust His ‘special ways’ to work for our benefit. I know from my own human experience and weakness, that sometimes I have no strength to continue, but I am glad for the FAITH given to me to help me continue my walk with Jesus. I want you to believe, dear believer in Christ, that your present sufferings are producing something precious in your life as you are being formed into a Grace Giver. One day God is going to use YOU to glorify His Son Jesus; without all the trials and suffering that you went through, it would be impossible to continue walking with Jesus. Yes, Jesus will continue interceding for you and me, and every believer, but you have to walk in FAITH with Him and in order to do THAT you need to know Him personally. My prayer for you today is that the Holy Spirit would direct your eyes to the Lord and to encourage you to see Him RIGHT NOW as YOUR High Priest. I pray that the Holy Spirit would help you to compare your sufferance with HIS and to open your eyes to what Jesus REALLY endured—HIS SOUL was put in fretters!!! I pray that the Lord would help us to be thankful to Him and that our hearts are full of gratitude to what He REALLY went through for our sake. Yes, He is RISEN, and for YOU, believer in the Risen Lord, I claim the Power and SPIRIT of Resurrection in Jesus holy name. May you be encouraged to trust YOUR Creator, than to trust your human wisdom or emotions.

## Prayer Ideas

1. Our hearts are full with gratitude to the One Who conquered death and saved us from eternal damnation, thus we give thanks to Jesus, the Author and Finisher of our faith, asking Him to continue using us for the spreading of the Good News and inviting people to His Kingdom.
2. Doors were opened in Amman, Jordan and the Lord used us to comfort His people through us, whether through a Word from the Bible, a time of listening to suffering believers, a prayer or some donation. We claim in Jesus holy name His mighty Presence in the lives of those to whom He sent us. We ask the Lord to confirm the Word we spoke in His name, whether through healing, open doors, revelation or else. We pray that the Lord would strengthen those people in their faith and open their eyes to His Eternal purposes.
3. Through the streets of Amman and other towns and places we prayed, proclaiming the name of Jesus; join us and claim great harvest. Ask the Lord to continue guiding us, where it is needed; it is true the world is full with evil, but there are some spots which needs special touch. Pray for the Youth in Jordan, because they have the heart of our Lord and love to reach out to non-believers.
4. We are facing different challenges while serving the Lord in the Middle East, because the environment is getting more hostile; we need Prayer Warriors to stand with us. Intercede for the millions of Muslims in the region, because all of them NEED Jesus. Do NOT see their evil deeds, but what Jesus did in Calvary; proclaim salvation upon the region DAILY and claim as many souls as possible to the Kingdom.
5. We've seen so many sick people; they were literally under physical attack whether young or old. Pray in Jesus holy name and claim healing; the blinded world around those Christians, needs a SIGN to have its eyes opened. Our God is able and willing because 'Our God is MIGHTY to save...' but where are the intercessors? May our God be glorified through our service and your prayers.
6. Many activities we had, whether serving the new converts in Iraq as it happened two weeks ago, or helping the needy, thus we appreciate your stand with us. In Jesus holy name we claim many intercessors for us, our Ministry and evangelizing; we need to be continuously covered through prayers in order to continue. If you could, ask the Church you go to, to pray for us and those we are serving. Beloved, local Servants need your prayers too; what happened in Sri Lanka is an example.
7. The more we serve, the more we need to finance our Ministry; God is the One to provide for us and in Jesus holy name we ask YOU to consider supporting us. We prayed and asked the Lord for Financial Independence; unit with us and claim abundance in Jesus holy name. We are facing many challenges to continue serving internationally in different countries; your stand could make a difference.
8. There are many international activities that we are joining, either directly through our presence, or through uniting with them through activities. We pray that you would **remember the DATES** and join other believers; the simplest thing you do could change the direction of a soul. We went on the streets and joined other believer who were evangelizing in Brno, Czech Republic a week after Resurrection Day, but we are going again on **Friday, May, 10<sup>th</sup>**. PLEASE start praying for us and claim the ground for the Lord in Blansko and ask the Lord for protection. We are claiming Open Heaven upon the region and asking for UNITY, wisdom from above and guidance.
9. Millions of believer worldwide are ALREADY praying for **G.O.D. (Global Outreach Day) on Saturday, May, 25<sup>th</sup>** – **JOIN THEM and encourage others to do the same**. It is important to do as Jesus commanded us and on such a day as **Global Outreach Day**, the Spirit will be busy; please KEEP Him busy and pray for salvation. God wants all men to be saved; let THIS be your motto, when you DO something, in Jesus holy name.

Finally we encourage you to keep the Word, live the Calling and continue serving in a humble heart WITHOUT fear, and don't ever forget your joy in the Lord no matter what might happen--- He will never fail you.

We also ask you, dear Saints, to forward our Messages to as many people as you can, whether Christians or else with many thanks. We would love to visit you, if invited to your Church, Prayer

Group or else and share our testimony with all the Saints or hear from you. Please let's know through an E-mail containing a phone number to write or call you back. We are waiting for your Commentaries too; what did the Message tell you and what did the Holy Spirit teach you? If you want us to pray for you, or for somebody else, please let us know and we will pass the name/s over to our 24/7 Prayer Team-Jesus Highland Prayer House- JHPH.
